The cycles given above have been used in the preparation of this calendar. The readings from the Proper of Time and Proper of Saints have been used for all Solemnities and all Feasts since they must take the place of the weekday readings for those respective days. The readings from the weekday cycle generally

are to be used even on days on which a Memorial or Optional Memorial of a Saint occurs, except unless otherwise stated. Substitutions from the Commons or Proper of Saints may be made from the other readings suggested for those Memorials or Optional Memorials. The Priest Celebrant, however, should not omit "too often or without sufficient cause the readings assigned for each day in the weekday Lectionary" (Introduction to the Lectionary for Mass, no. 83). In this calendar, Optional Memorials are designated by the use of italics within brackets.

The Scripture citations and Lectionary numbers for all readings are from the Lectionary for Mass for Use in the Dioceses of the United States of America, second typical edition (1998/2001), and the Lectionary for Ms Supplement (2017), which is based on the Ordo Lectionum Missæ, editio typica altera (1981). The spellings of the names of Saints and Blesseds are from the Roman Missal, Third Edition (2011), based on the Missale Romanum, editio typica tertia emendata (2008).

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

- 1. Scripture citations are based on the English Standard Version (ESVCE) and may differ slightly from the citations given in the *Ordo Lectionum Missæ* (1981) due to difference in versification.
- 2. In the preparation of diocesan and provincial Calendars and *ordines*, the dedication of diocesan cathedrals, the dedication of parish churches, and special days of prayer (cf. General Instruction of the Roman Missal [GIRM], no. 373) should be added, along with other commemorations of Saints and Blessed which are included in those particular Calendars. More information is available in the Universal Norms on the Liturgical Year and the Calendar, particularly Chapter II.

- 3. "On Saturdays in Ordinary Time when no Obligatory Memorial occurs, an Optional Memorial of the Blessed Virgin Mary may be celebrated" (Universal Norms on the Liturgical Year and the Calendar, no. 15). This is indicated in the calendar by "BVM." The readings and prayers may be selected from the Common of the Blessed Virgin Mary or Votive Masses of the Blessed Virgin Mary in the Roman Missal, or the Collection of Masses of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
- 4. This liturgical calendar has entries for Independence Day and Republic Day, since they are inscribed in the Proper Calendar for the Dioceses of India, but it does not include other civic holidays commonly celebrated in this country (for example, Diwali, Onam, Pongal, etc.). Respecting the liturgical norms (cf. GIRM, nos. 368-378), the Roman Missal offers appropriate Masses, but this calendar makes no suggestions for those holy days.
- 5. The 2023 liturgical year begins on the First Sunday of Advent. November 27, 2022.

During the year 2023:

a. Thursday, May 18 is the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. This Solemnity transferred to the following Sunday, May 21, 2023. May 18 is observed either as an Easter weekday.

b. Whenever a celebration like Independence Day, etc., occurs on a Sunday, Independence Day or any other occasion may be appropriately acknowledged in the Homily, Universal Prayer, and hymns during the Sunday liturgy.

c. It is permissible to take the Readings from the Proper of Saints on the Memorials of the Indian Saints mentioned in the Liturgical Calendar. Alternative readings are indicated for these memorials.

ADVENT

Advent has a twofold character. It is firstly a season to prepare for Christmas, when Christ's first coming to us is remembered, and secondly a season when that remembrance directs the mind and heart to await Christ's Second Coming at the end of time. Advent is thus a period of devout and joyful expectation. (LY 39)

During Advent, the playing of the organ and other musical instruments and the decoration of the altar with flowers should be done in a moderate manner, as is consonant with the character of the season, without anticipating the full joy of the Nativity of the Lord. The same moderation should be observed in the celebration of Matrimony.

ORDINARY TIME Before Lent

The Church celebrates the paschal mystery on the first day of each week, known as the Lord's Day or Sunday. This follows a tradition handed down from the apostles and having its origin from the day of Christ's

resurrection. Thus, Sunday must be ranked as the first feast day of all. (GNLY 4).

The Sundays of this season do not celebrate a specific aspect of the mystery of Christ. Instead, they are devoted to the mystery of Christ in all its aspects.

Note: On any weekday 'in the year', when the Mass is of choice. the priest can choose any of the Masses found in the Missal, except the Ritual Masses. However, the following should be taken into account

- The priest has to pay attention first to the spiritual good of the people, not his own ideas.
- Ordinary Masses for the dead will be celebrated moderately since every Mass is offered for both the living and the dead.
- On an optional memorial of Our Lady or any Saint, the devotion of the faithful should be satisfied

Season of Lent:

Lent is a Preparation for the celebration of Easter, For the Lenten liturgy disposes both catechumens and the faithful to celebrate the paschal mystery: catechumens, through the several stages of Christian initiation; the faithful, through reminders of their own baptism and through penitential Practices.

Holy Week, which begins on the 6th Sunday of Lent, Passion [Palm] Sunday, has as its purpose the remembrance of Christ's passion, beginning with his Messianic entrance into Jerusalem.

- 1. "Alleluia" is omitted until the Easter Vigil
- 2. The Preface of Lent is said every day unless otherwise indicated
- In Mass weekday, the Opening Prayer may be replaced by the Prayer of the Saint whose commemoration occurs on that day,

- At Mass, no Rite of Penance, The Ashes are blessed and distributed after the Gospel and Homily

HOLY WEEK

In Holy week the Church celebrates the mysteries of salvation accomplished by Christ in the last days of his earthly life, from his messianic entry into Jerusalem until his blessed Passion and glorious Resurrection. Lent continues until Holy Thursday.

Notes:

General: The rite of the blessing of Palms, the Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on Maundy Thursday, the Good Friday Liturgical Service and the Easter Vigil may be celebrated in all Churches and public or semi-public Oratories. If they cannot be conducted with enough dignity (servers, singing, participating faithful), it is better to have them only in Parish Churches

For Palm Sunday:

- a) Red vestments for all ceremonies today
- b) Christ's entry into Jerusalem may be recalled as a Procession, a Solemn Entrance or a Simple Entrance. The Solemn Entrance may be repeated but not the Procession.
- No Blessing of Palms without Mass, the celebrant must be the same for both.

- d) At the Procession or Solemn Entrance, the Mass begins with the Opening Prayer of the day.
- e) Lay readers may proclaim the Gospel of the Passion; preferably a Priest should take the part of Christ.

THE "PASCHAL TRIDUUM" Note:

Easter Triduum:

Begins with the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, reaches its high point in the Easter Vigil and concludes with Evening Prayer on Easter Sunday.

Christ redeemed us all and gave perfect glory to God Principally through his paschal mystery: dying he destroyed our death and rising he restored our life; Therefore, the Easter Triduum of the passion and resurrection of Christ is the culmination of the entire

liturgical year, The solemnity of Easter has the kind of Pre-eminence in the year that Sunday has in the week. [PASSION AND RESURRECTION – WITH "P" AND "R" CAPITALISED,]

Notes:

- Masses without people are not allowed, On Maundy Thursday evening, for pastoral reasons the Ordinary may allow one or two Masses besides the main Mass of the Lord's Supper
- On Maundy Thursday Holy Communion may be distributed only during the Mass; on Good Friday only during the Liturgical Service, But Communion may be brought to the sick on both days, On Holy Saturday, Communion may be given only as Viaticum,
- c) On Thursday and Friday, Vespers may be omitted by those who participate in the Liturgical Service of the day, those who participate in the Easter Vigil may omit the Saturday Compline and the Office of Readings of Easter Sunday

- a) The Celebration of the Passion of the Lord must be held at a convenient hour after noontime' usually around 3.00 pm, for pastoral reasons, however, it may be held at a later hour.
- b) The Priest and the deacon use red vestments, as at Mass, right from the beginning of the Liturgical action.
- At the beginning, the Altar must be bare without cloths, candles or cross.
- d) Holy Communion is to be distributed to the faithful only within the Celebration of the Passion of the Lord it may however, be distributed at any hour of the day to the sick who are unable to participate in the Liturgy.
- e) After the celebration of the Passion of the Lord, the Blessed Sacrament is to be taken back in a simple form to the place of reservation, there it is to be reserved as is the custom with a lamp lit, Privately, The Altar is bare, Now, however, the Cross and the candles may be left on it.

- f) Today after the unveiling of the Cross and tomorrow until the Easter Vigil begins, we bow/ genuflect; to the Cross.
- g) Collection taken is for the Sacred Places in the Holy Land.

08 HOLY SATURDAY

Note: The Liturgy of the Hours is celebrated with the special features indicated in the Proper of Time, Holy Communion may not be distributed today before the Easter Vigil, except as Viaticum,

THE EASTER SEASON:

The Easter Season begins with celebration of the Easter Vigil on Easter Sunday and concludes 50 days later with Pentecost Sunday, the fifty days from Easter Sunday to Pentecost are celebrated in joyful exultation as one feast day, or better as one 'Great Sunday' These are above all others the days for the singing of the Alleluia,

Notes for the Season

- a) The Easter Candle is kept near the altar or the lectern, it is lit at all Masses during the Octave and on all Sunday Masses of the Easter Season
- b) On weekdays, during the Masses of the Season, Votive Masses and daily Masses for the dead are not allowed except for pastoral reasons, But the Mass of the Saint whose Memorial occurs on that day may be said,

Notes for the Easter Vigil

- The entire Liturgical Service is celebrated at night
- There is no 'service followed by Mass,' but the Liturgy of the Eucharist is part of the entire Vigil Service, The faithful must clearly be instructed on this point,
- The celebration of Mass without the Easter Vigil Service is not allowed,
- d) For the entire Liturgical action, the Sacred Ministers dress in White vestments,
- e) In case of necessity, the Easter Proclamation (Exsultet) may be sung by a cantor who is not a deacon, in this case the blessing of the deacon is omitted,
- Priests who celebrate or concelebrate at the Vigil Service may celebrate or concelebrate again on Easter Sunday, the faithful may similarly receive Communion again,

The Sundays of this season do not celebrate a specific aspect of the mystery of Christ. Instead, they are devoted to the mystery of Christ in all its aspects.
